American student at the University of

California, Berkeley when she enrolled in 1968
at 21. The next year, LaNada used her freedom

of assembly to organize the Occupation of

Alcatraz, a peaceful protest hoping to reclaim
the island "in the name of all American Indians."

LaNada was one of the very few who stayed on
the island for the entire 19-month occupation.
